From 2001 to 2007 I was a at the RAF Air Warfare Centre at RAF Waddington. As a part of my duties I recieved daily intelligence briefings at up to Top Secret Strap 2 level on the Iraq conflict. To my recollection at no point did the information and intelligence being briefed to the senior management of the RAF differ from the position being taken by politicians and ministers. I conclude that any failings were in inteligence gathering and analysis by the military and intelligence services and not deliberate distortion of intelligence for political ends by ministers, as has been suggested.
